



# Health Related Social Needs Programs

Open Sky offers services in partnership with Mass Health as well as several ACOs such as Revere Medical, C3 and UMass/Tufts to help individuals who are experiencing challenges with homelessness, housing instability, conditions in their home that are unhealthy, and food insecurity.

## Services offered:

- **Community Supports Program for Homeless Individuals (CSPHI)**  
Navigator program with a focus on mental health and providing assistance for individuals experiencing homelessness at any age.
- **Housing Search** for individuals 55 years old and older who are experiencing homelessness.
- **Resources** for individuals transitioning from homelessness into housing such as first and last month's rent, security deposit, and furniture.
- **Housing Navigation** for individuals having repeated instances of emergency department visits and experiencing housing instability.
- **Healthy Homes** for individuals living in unhealthy housing or housing that is physically unsafe due to their disability or medical condition.
- **Nutrition Vouchers** for individuals with very low food security.
- **Kitchen Supplies** for individuals with very low food security.
